

Free Adult Nurse Assistant Program

*For Appalachian Region Residents only**

The Adult Nurse Assistant program, offered for free in Cobleskill by the Capital Region BOCES Adult Education Program and Health Careers Center, is a great starting place for individuals who would like to work as a supportive caregiver in a health care setting or pursue further education in Practical Nursing or other health-related disciplines.

Students learn total patient care in both the classroom and through off-campus, supervised clinical experiences. Students prepare for the New York State Certified Nurse Assistant examination. Such certification qualifies them to work in any nursing home in the state.

PREADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum age: 17

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful interview
- Professional and personal references
- Physical exam and immunizations
- Each NA candidate must have a volunteer patient on the day of the state test
